Our History

The original Christian Living Community (CLC) at University Hills was founded and created by members of the Christian Reformed and Reformed Churches of America. They were descendents of Dutch Calvinist immigrants who came to this country in the nineteenth century. They believed that the Christian community should band together to meet the needs of all community members. In Denver, those forward-thinking men and women dreamed of churches, Christian schools, hospitals, welfare agencies and senior service organizations.

In 1972, local church members believed that a Christian community must care for its members including their senior adults. This group opened a 62-bed nursing home called University Hills Christian Nursing Home. This was the beginning of the Christian Living Communities.

Today CLC has multiple communities that serve the needs of nearly 700 residents and clients each day spanning a broad range of denominations and religious affiliations while maintaining ministry as the center of its mission. CLC offers a true continuum of care with independent living, assisted living, skilled nursing, dementia care, adult day and home care services.

The Christian Living Communities Stewardship Fund was created as the fundraising arm of CLC. Under the guidance of a team of community members and CLC executives, the Stewardship Fund actively seeks donations that will directly "enrich the lives of seniors."

In the future, the Stewardship Fund will look for financial solutions to help CLC shoulder the ever increasing burden of offering quality care and services to people who need them, during a time the cost of providing that care is ever increasing.

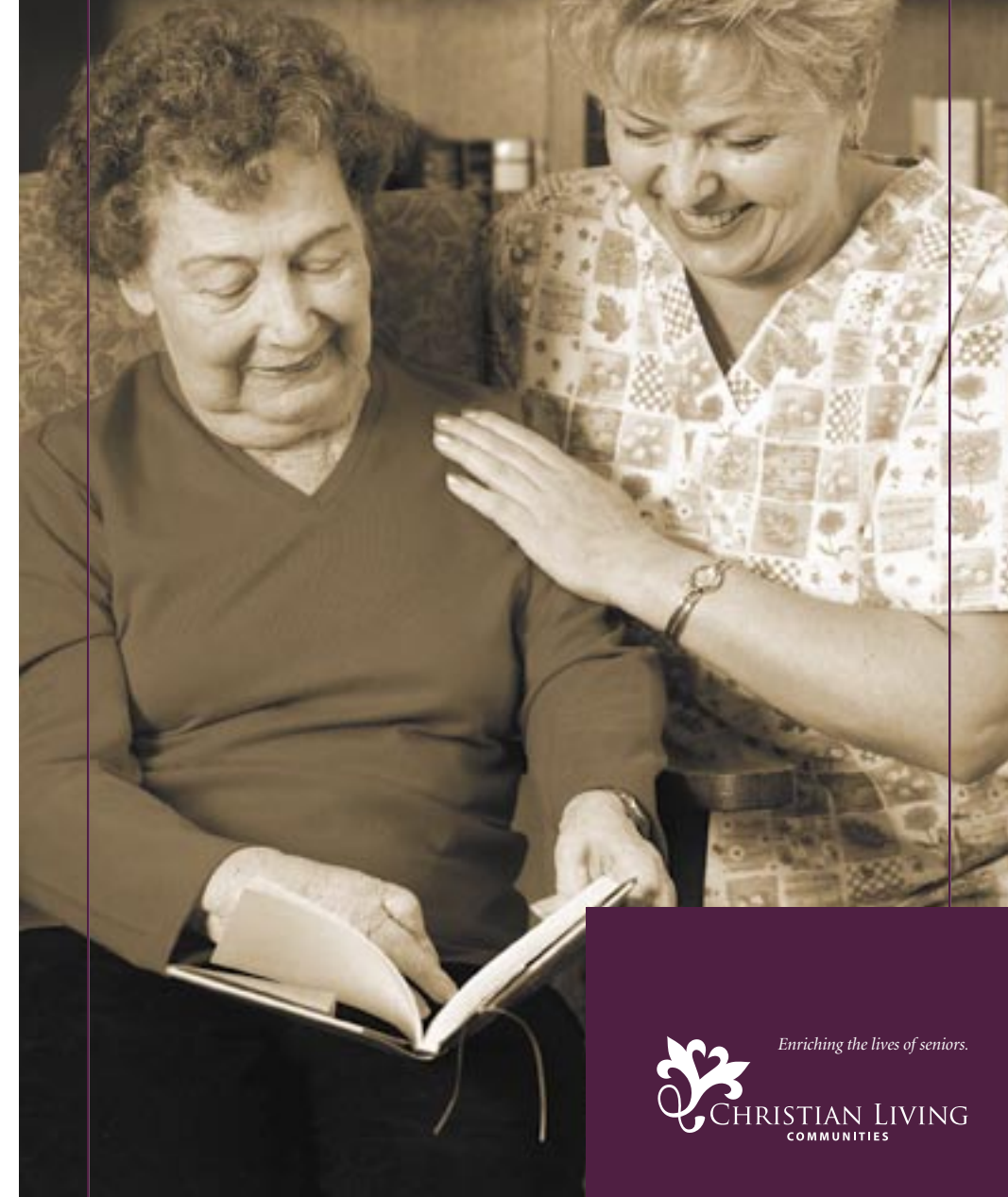
