### ADULT DAY SERVICES AT THE JOHNSON CENTER

## HOW YOU CAN

### *Enrich the lives of seniors*

You have a wide variety of options when it comes to supporting CLC.

Planned giving—or deferred gifts, is the integration of your personal, financial and estate plans with your goals for charitable giving.

Each quarter we will share with you some of the various methods people use when supporting their favorite charities.

#### **Bequests**

Many people wish to support CLC but are unable to donate property or assets while they're alive.

By including your favorite charities (like CLC) in your will, living trust, IRA or insurance policy you retain control of your property while you are alive but you help CLC upon your passing.

In some of these arrangements, the bequest is not subject to federal estate taxes—giving your family a break when settling your estate. You can even pass an individual retirement account to CLC by naming us as a beneficiary.

Bequests can be a set amount or a percentage of your estate.

While they are not tax-deductible during your lifetime, bequests do offer advantages such as being revocable, confidential, and offer you the opportunity to leave a legacy that will help many generations of seniors.
